Beginning January 1, 2012, the HCDP Contribution Category of "Life Membership" will be replaced as follows:

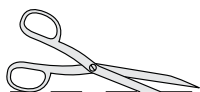
- Gold Donor - \$1,000.00 or more

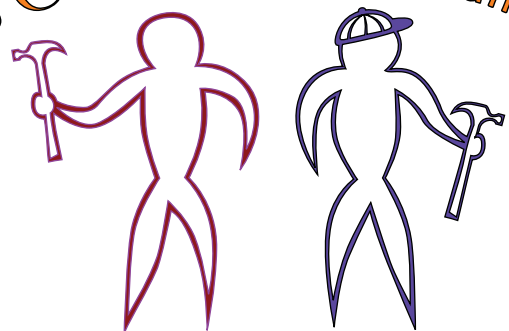
